Fair Oaks Library Expansion Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Presentation by Derek Wolfgram, Director of the Redwood City Public Library • A new “Teen Zone” is planned for the back of the library. • All areas of the library are being re-designed so that there are more spaces for people to sit and read, do homework, or other activities • The library will be moving to a small room in the Fair Oaks Community Center during construction so that the community still has access to a library. • Construction is expected to take about 2-3 months • The library will be expanding from 2400 Sq.Ft. to 3200 Sq.Ft.
