Hi Neil,

Thanks for the reports. Jessie tells me you are working with Noel and Bob to fix the temporary erosion controls. Regarding resolving the stormwater run-on problem from the street and associated erosion impacts, she tells me you are reviewing the permanent drainage system plans and preparing an explanation for constructing the permanent drainage system. As a Qualified Stormwater Practitioner (QSP), we hope you can advise the County as to whether this construction work is necessary for erosion control and/or to protect water quality, provide a schedule of work, and advise as to whether a revised or new temporary erosion control plan should be prepared and implemented while the permanent system is being constructed.
